

## Cyclone Plotting Map

When advice is issued the position of a cyclone is given both a longitude and latitude reading as a 16-point compass bearing. To plot the cyclone's route yourself use the longitude (vertical lines) and latitude (horizontal lines) readings and make them on the map.

Remember that readings are given for the "eye" of the cyclone, which is the centre. Gale force winds may be experienced on the coast many hours and hundreds of kilometers ahead of the cyclone's centre.
