Who can borrow?

- Members of Weipa Library can borrow items
- Membership is available to residents and/or ratepayers of QLD, businesses or organisations based in Weipa

How do you join the Weipa Library?

- Residents, businesses or organisations can join at the Weipa Library, or download the Adult membership application and return the completed form to the Library with the required ID.
- Children under 18 will need to be accompanied by an adult for the provision of ID. Junior membership application.
- Visitors may become members upon payment of a refundable deposit.

How many items can be borrowed and for how long?

- Up to fourteen items at one time may be borrowed - twelve books and two DVD's
- You may reserve any item currently on loan to another borrower. The library will notify you when the item is available for collection.
- You can request books to be reserved or order books that are not currently listed at the Weipa Library by filling out the book request form located in this website under Online Services.
- Books can be loaned for three weeks, however, if you require items for a longer period please contact the library on (07) 4030 9408 to extend your loan (providing another member has not reserved the items).

How are items returned?

- Items may be returned to the Weipa Library at any time. During hours books can be returned to the front counter. After-hours books can be returned via the after-hours return bin located on the right-hand side at the Library entrance.
